## IV. PROPOSITIONS

District Clerk, Betty Ann Post, read the following propositions:

### PROPOSITION 1: THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL BUDGET

Shall the following Proposition be adopted, to wit? BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Education of the South Kortright Central School District is authorized to expend the sum not to exceed \$10,518,663 for the school year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020.

### PROPOSITION 2: PURCHASE OF SCHOOL BUSES

Shall the following Proposition be adopted, to wit? BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Education of the South Kortright Central School District is authorized to expend the sum not to exceed \$190,000 for the purchase of two buses, one 65 passenger and one 66 passenger school bus. The purchase of the bus is to be paid from the District's bus reserve for the school year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020.

### PROPOSITION 3: FUNDING OF THE REPAIR RESERVE

Shall the following Proposition be adopted, to wit? BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Education of the South Kortright Central School District be authorized and directed to fund the Repair Reserve Fund that was established by the Board of Education on February 11, 2019. The ultimate amount of such fund shall be \$250,000. The source of its funds shall be from unappropriated balances in the District's general fund in current and future years.

## VI. BOARD OF EDUCATION VACANCY

District Clerk, Betty Ann Post, read the following vacancy:

Voters are asked to elect one Board member for a five year term for the following vacancy:

Last Incumbent: Terri Chichester

Terri Chichester has filed a petition for the open Board of Education seat and is seeking re-election to this vacancy.

## VII. VOTER QUALIFICATIONS

District Clerk, Betty Ann Post, read the qualifications for voting:

>You must be a citizen of the United States of America

>18 years of age,

>A resident of the District for a period of 30 days before this Election

It was also noted that voting will take place in the Gymnasium Lobby, parking will be available behind the school.
